
Living and Working in Germany

What are the requirements for participants?

- ✓ Holding a professional qualification in Early Childhood Education
 - Laurea scienze dell'Educazione (L19)
 - Laurea scienze dell'Educazione e della Formazione (L19)
- ✓ Residence + nationality of an EU member state or EU permanent residence permit (in case of citizenship of a third country)
- ✓ Willingness to learn German intensively in Italy up to level A2
- ✓ Willingness to continue learning German for 12 months in Germany in order to obtain a German B2 certificate (this certificate will be necessary to continue the project)
- ✓ Later on selected candidates will further need to present
 - a proof of a current criminal record certificate
 - a vaccination against measles (or immunity to it) and
 - o an instruction according to the Infection Protection Act
- ✓ Willingness to live and work in Germany for a long time





There are many advantages for the participants in the project:

- ✓ Permanent employment contract with a 6 month probationary period in a nursery school in the city or district of Munich with starting date as of February 1st, 2026
